## MISSION UPDATE



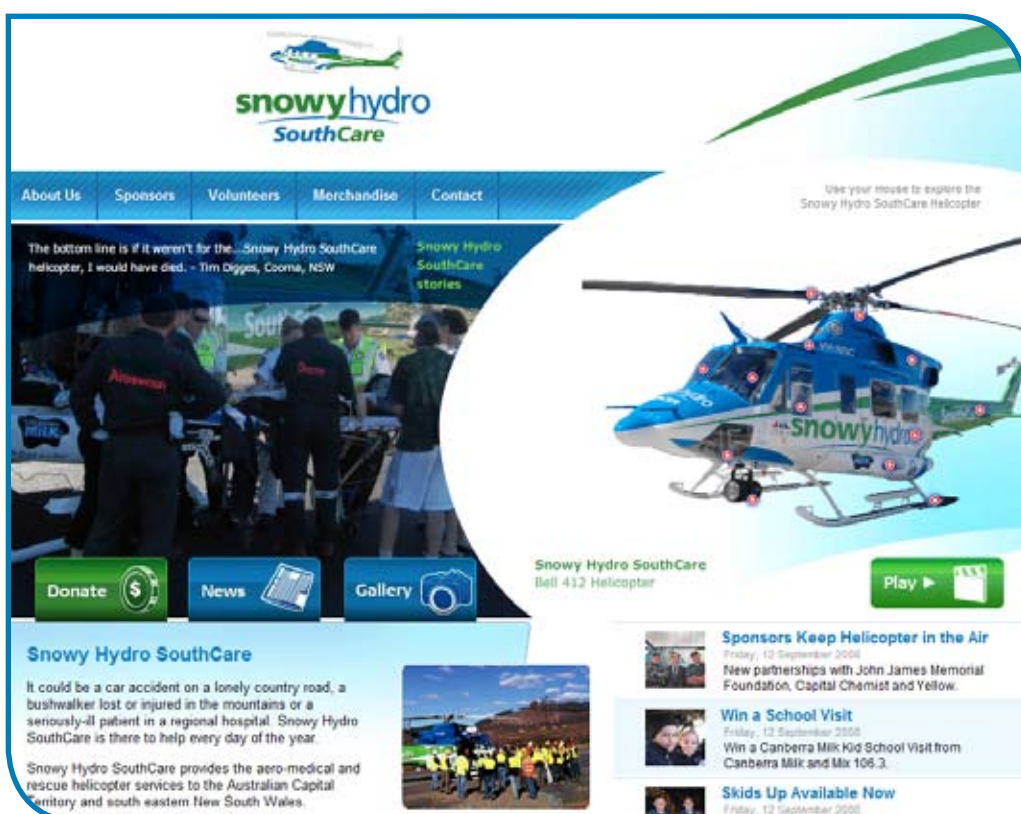
Snowy Hydro SouthCare has been busy at the snowfields this season.

Over the last month, the Service has completed 35 missions including seven missions transporting patients who injured themselves while at the snowfields.

This month's missions also include the winch of a man from the Mimoso Africana, a wood chip shipping vessel that was located in Snug Cove, Eden at the time of the mission. The man had a broken leg and was winched from the vessel and transported to The Canberra Hospital for treatment on September 10th.

The amazing rescue of Karina Scott was also completed this month. Karina, a 31-year-old bush walker was found in the Namadgi National Park after spending three nights in freezing conditions. Karina said, "I just felt the strength of my family," which allowed her to keep going throughout the ordeal. She was air-lifted to The Canberra Hospital showing signs of exhaustion and an incredible will to survive. To celebrate her upcoming birthday, her partner Danny said he will be getting her an EPIRB (emergency position indicating radio beacon).
