Snowy Hydro SouthCare Searches for Lost Females (Update)

The Snowy Hydro SouthCare Rescue Helicopter was tasked earlier this evening to participate in a search and possible rescue of two young females (believed to be somewhere between teens and early 20's) in the Brindabella Ranges around Mount Ginini. Original reports indicated suspected injuries.

Both females have now been located and returned to the Snowy Hydro SouthCare base. Whilst paramedics are attending to the girls they do not require any hospital treatment.

Information to hand is that the two girls were suffering from dehydration and were vomiting. A third member of the group was able to reach higher ground where mobile phone communication could be achieved.
